Enhancements

Vacation Pay Payable Report Rendering

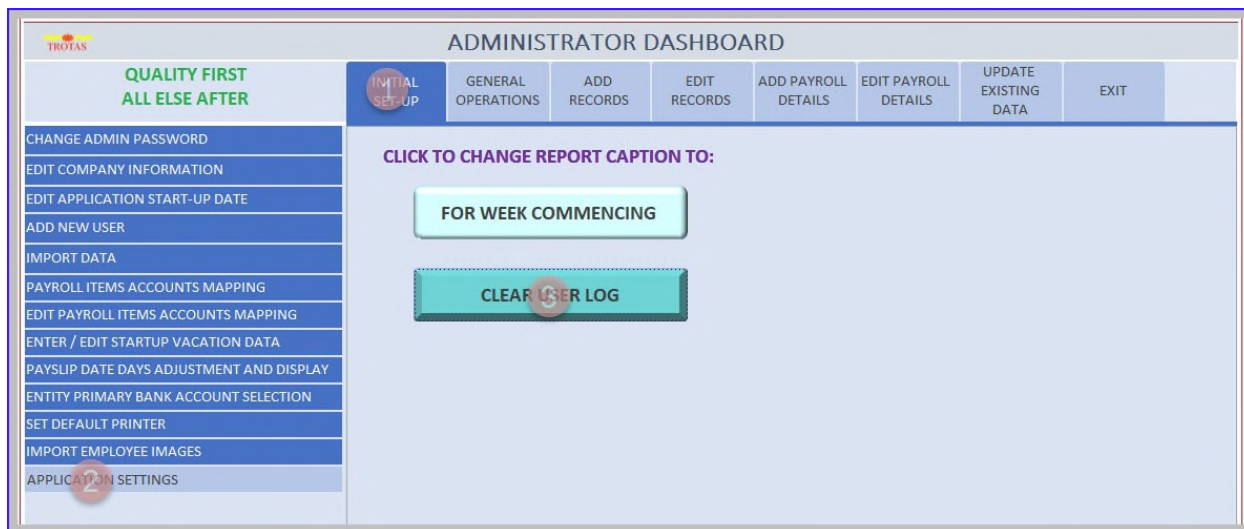
Vacation Pay Payable Report now renders instantly; long wait time has been eliminated.

License Validation

Unlicensed Workstations are now presented with a license validation dialogue at application Start-Up

Clear Logged out user record

A button has been added to the user interface (Horizontal Menu - Initial Setup, Vertical Menu - Settings) that allow administrators to clear logged out user record that sometimes remain following improper application shut down.



Fixes

Vacation Pay Report Streamlined

Vacation Pay Report now filters out 0 (zero) vacation pay amounts. They are no longer available for selection.

Rehired Employees Data

Vacation Pay data from prior employment stints are no longer a part of that of the data for the current stint.

Data Entry Forms

The Save and Clear buttons on data entry forms now become disabled after “duplicates available” error message and forms’ data is reset.

Application Start Date Errors Elimination

Application Start Date form was generating some errors on application first-run. Those errors have been eliminated.

Single Application Instance

Procedures designed to prevent the application from running multiple times on the same workstation simultaneously was preventing compilation on 64-bit machines. That issue has been resolved.

Business Rep Entry Form

Associated businesses remained available for selection after they were selected for related business rep entry.

Employee Import

Employee import procedure was producing errors. Commas are not allowed in data supplied via .csv files.

Database Restore Procedure

Database Restore procedure was prevented from complete execution by a lock file that was present the database container.

Un-Needed Back-end tables

Removed some un-needed tables from the Back-end database.

Maintenance (Single User) Mode

In some cases, the system remained locked and inaccessible to potential users following the completion of the important procedure that locked it. That issue has been addressed in this release.
